

Year 7 Catch Up Grant 2015-16

- In 2015-16 £7000 Catch Up funding was received to support 7 students in Maths and 7 students in English who arrived with KS2 results below level 4 in one or both subjects.
- This grant was used to fund small group specialist teaching as part of the student's curriculum timetable. Some students also received extra support through reading and spelling groups.
- Student Voice and Work Scrutiny of these small groups have shown evidence that student confidence is increased and written evidence (particularly CPR evidence) shows clear student progress.
- The results have shown this programme has been effective with an average increase in sublevel of 3.2 in English and 2.2 in Maths. An analysis of the results is shown below:

Year 7 Catch Up Grant 2016-17

- In 2016-17 we expect to receive £7500 in funding which will allow the continuation of provision of small groups for English and Maths in addition to interventions through the RAIL programme.
- There are 20 students in a transition support pathway for English and 13 for Maths in year 7 this year.
